DIÁLOGOS DUO Residencies support and enhance a music institution's core academic and artistic mission with Brazilian music performance and curricula.

Implementing its acclaimed ORIGINAL REPERTOIRE and works of Brazilian masters in a broad scope of course sectors, residencies are designed for all instrumentalists, vocalists and composers based in classical, jazz, Latin music and other genres.

RESIDENCY TYPES

The DUO offers three types of residencies: ONSITE, VIRTUAL and HYBRID.

• ONSITE residencies are presented at educational host institutions as follows:

LOCAL: up to 200 miles driving from New York City (1-3 days) or **DISTANCE**: within one of **four designated ZONES of flight travel** (2+ days) (p.6)

- VIRTUAL residencies are presented via ZOOM, providing access to a larger group of participants. They also forego any artist travel and lodging expenses.
- HYBRID residencies are comprised of VIRTUAL and ONSITE events. They typically unfold over a longer timeframe- up to a semester (or quarter).

RESIDENCY COMPONENTS

INITIAL CONSULTATION

RESIDENCY COMPONENT A Diálogos Duo member and Host Site faculty/administrator explore options to finalize all residency activities, timeframe/schedule, fees, travel and lodging arrangements. This is accomplished via Zoom, e mails and other communications.

RESIDENCY FOCUS and LENGTH

- LOCAL and DISTANCE ONSITE RESIDENCIES (1-3+ running days) feature a Diálogos Duo CONCERT, CONVOCATION and select EDUCATIONAL components of interest to the Host Site. For 3+ day Residencies, a STUDENT CONCERT of prepared Diálogos Duo repertoire and a Diálogos Duo CONCERT of new repertoire is featured.
- VIRTUAL RESIDENCIES can be presented anywhere on the globe and within a variety of timeframes: from one day to an entire semester/quarter.

A longer timeframe facilitates STUDENT preparation and performance of predetermined Diálogos Duo repertoire. For institutions located far from New York City, Virtual residencies save considerably on artist travel and lodging expenses.

• HYBRID RESIDENCIES offer maximum flexibility for engaging a diversity of students, faculty and curriculum sectors, and more opportunities for individual Duo member specialty presentations for all instrumentalists and vocalists.

HYBRID residencies usually begin with VIRTUAL components scheduled at appropriate intervals (ex. two-three weeks): CONVOCATION, MASTERCLASS CYCLE (Clarinet and Guitar Studios, Duos) and other educational presentations. As schedule permits, a second onsite MASTERCLASS CYCLE can occur before a STUDENT CONCERT.

Such pacing of events provides students and their supervising faculty adequate time to prepare select Diálogos Duo repertoire for a STUDENT DUO CONCERT, which occurs during Diálogos Duo's ONSITE visit.

The current work of focus is "CHORO TRIBUTES", featured on Diálogos Duo's latest CD and DIGITAL PLAYALONG BUNDLE.

Participating clarinet and guitar students and studio faculty are given free access to the DIGITAL PLAYALONG BUNDLE (DPB), a ZIP FILE containing:

- REMIXED CD AUDIO with L/R CLARINET/GUITAR isolation and click count-offs
- SCORES and PARTS COMPOSER COMMENTARY USER GUIDE

CURRICULUM THINKTANK

The Duo offers Host Site faculty and administration the opportunity to discuss their current curricula, explore ideas for expansion and development, including the integration of Brazilian music with classical, jazz and other contemporary idioms.

This curriculum thinktank process can include Duo members dropping in on classes.

The fee for such consultation and exploration will be commensurate with the scope of discussions and related activities.

Louis Arques taught at the Paris Conservatoire for ten years. He is visiting faculty at Ithaca College, Cornell University and ongoing faculty at Diller-Quaile School of Music (NYC).

Richard Boukas has thirty-eight years of university teaching experience in North America and Brazil. He has been faculty at New School for Performing Arts (NYC) since 1989.

OPTIONAL PRIVATE / SEMI-PRIVATE INSTRUCTION

As a **Residency itinerary** permits, Private Lessons with Diálogos Duo member(s) can be scheduled. They can also be conducted virtually via Zoom prior to or after a residency. Lessons with two or more students together are also possible. Inquire about lesson topics offered. All lessons and fees are scheduled and paid by the student(s), apart from main residency activities.

DIÁLOGOS DUO ORIGINAL REPERTOIRE for PERFORMANCE

Richard Boukas's current body of work composed for the Duo is:

8 suites, 87 movements. The Suites are as follows:

- Sambistas Imortais (20)
- Diálogos for Clarinet & Guitar (7)
- Three Choros for Bass Clarinet & Guitar

- Diálogos for Bass Clarinet & Guitar (7)
- Centenário (8)

DUO CONCERTS can present a single suite or combine selections from multiple works. Repertoire is always different from what is used in the Student Duo Program.

Concerts are 80 minutes in length. Program notes are provided.

Final repertoire choices are at the discretion of Diálogos Duo.

RESIDENCY ENGAGEMENT and OUTREACH

The primary focus of THREE-DAY (PLUS) residencies is the **STUDENT DUO PROGRAM** with select Clarinetists and Guitarists. With permission of key faculty and as space safely allows, residency events are open to all program instrumentalists, vocalists, composers, students of theory, ethnomusicology and other concentrations.

ANCHOR and SATELLITE INSTITUTIONS, REFERRAL INCENTIVES

An ANCHOR INSTITUTION is a music program which arranges a residency of a minimum two days. If the Institution is farther than LOCAL TRAVEL (> 200 miles driving), they are responsible for the cost of roundtrip airfare, local transportation from and to the local airport and lodgings during the duration of the residency.

A residency is often expanded to other **SATELLITE** (local area) institutions which express interest in hosting the Duo. Such activities are arranged with each SATELLITE institution on terms separate from the ANCHOR INSTITUTION residency agreement.

REFERRAL INCENTIVE:

Forwarding this BROCHURE to prospective SATELLITE institutions is appreciated.

If a minimum one-day residency at a SATELLITE institution is facilitated by a recommendation from the ANCHOR INSTITUTION, an additional EDUCATIONAL COMPONENT is presented by Diálogos Duo at the ANCHOR institution at no additional cost.

Topic is chosen from the catalog of Duo and individual member specialties listed on page 4.

ONSITE RESIDENCY DISTANCE ZONES

Applies to residencies farther than LOCAL TRAVEL (> 200 miles driving).

Distance is defined by four ZONES which increase residency fees incrementally.

ZONE 1 less than 600 miles (one-hour flight or greater than 200 miles driving)

ZONE 2 600-1200 miles (up to a two-hour flight)

ZONE 3 1200-1800 miles (three to four-hour flight)

ZONE 4 greater than 1800 miles to West Coast

All ZONES require a minimum TWO DAYS of residency activities.
