Founded 2016 in New York City, *Diálogos Duo* is the preeminent U.S. clarinet-guitar duo specializing in contemporary Brazilian music. "*Diálogos*" means "*Dialogues*" in Portuguese.

Virtuoso clarinetist Louis Arques is from Grenoble, France and a Vandoren artist. Effortlessly negotiating Brazilian music's complex melodies and rhythms, Richard Boukas provides robust guitar accompaniments which capture the authentic character of each Brazilian genre.

Boukas's prolific compositions for the Duo comprise the largest body of contemporary Brazilian repertoire for clarinet and guitar worldwide: nine suites, one hundred (100) movements. His works fuse traditional and popular Brazilian genres (*samba, choro, baião, frevo, maracatu, maxixe, valsa, etc.*) with contemporary jazz and classical vocabularies. Each movement is a compelling tribute to a legendary Brazilian composer/musician.

The Duo's two recordings are: Choro Tributes (2020) and Homages to Brazilian Masters (2018).

Keynote performances include *ClarinetFest* (International Clarinet Association, 2021, 2019), Jazz Forum (Tarrytown, NY), NYC Classical Guitar Society, Sacred Heart University "Art of the Duo" (CT) and repeat broadcasts on Performance Today (American Public Media) and WKCR-FM Jobim Marathon (Columbia Univ.). The Duo presents educational residencies in Brazilian music performance, composition, history and related musical disciplines.

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
